

Accessibility Review Checklist

WCAG 2.2 AA, pre-launch sheet. Page 1 of 2

Before you open a browser

- ☐ Every image has alt text, or is marked decorative on purpose
 - ☐ Headings run in order and there is exactly one h1
 - ☐ Form fields have visible labels, not placeholder-only labels
 - ☐ Link text makes sense read on its own, out of context
 - ☐ Language is set on the html element
 - ☐ Page has a title that names the page before the site
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Colour and contrast

- ☐ Body text meets 4.5 to 1 against its background
 - ☐ Large text over 24 px meets 3 to 1
 - ☐ Interface borders and icons meet 3 to 1
 - ☐ No information is carried by colour alone
 - ☐ Focus indicator meets 3 to 1 against both the component and the page
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Motion

- ☐ Nothing autoplays for longer than five seconds without a control
- ☐ Parallax and large movement respect reduced motion
- ☐ No content flashes more than three times a second

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Keyboard and screen reader

- ☐ Every interactive element is reachable with Tab
 - ☐ Focus order matches the visual order
 - ☐ Focus is never trapped, except in a dialog that can be escaped
 - ☐ Skip link is the first focusable element and becomes visible
 - ☐ Dialogs return focus to the control that opened them
 - ☐ Custom controls announce name, role and state
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Zoom and reflow

- ☐ Page works at 200 percent text zoom with no loss of content
 - ☐ Page reflows to a 320 px wide viewport without horizontal scrolling
 - ☐ Content is not cut off when line height is increased to 1.5
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Documents and media

- ☐ PDFs have a document title and a tagged reading order
 - ☐ Video has captions, audio has a transcript
 - ☐ Downloads state the format and the file size
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Sign off requires a keyboard-only pass and one screen reader pass on the primary flow.
